



Archdiocesan Enrolment Committee

The Archdiocesan Enrolment Committee will advise the Director of Catholic Education on enrolment matters in the Archdiocese as follows:

- (a) Monitor the Catholic/non-Catholic Eastern Church enrolments for each school and the strategies undertaken by schools to attain/maintain a high level of Catholic enrolment.
- (b) Identify and assist schools which are experiencing difficulty in increasing/maintaining their enrolment of Catholic students.
- (c) Respond to requests by schools relating to their inability to increase their Catholic/non-Catholic Eastern Church percentage.
- (d) Monitor and assist secondary schools in terms of the Year 7 enrolment ceilings and priority parish arrangements.
- (e) Advise the Director on strategies to assist in the resolution of any complaints by schools concerning the enrolment practices of other schools.
- (f) Assist in establishing a higher profile for Catholic education so that all Catholic families are aware of and welcomed by the appropriate Catholic school.

Membership of the Archdiocesan Enrolment Committee

- Chair (appointed by the Director of Catholic Education)
- Representative of congregation-owned schools
- Representative of regional secondary schools
- 2 representatives of Catholic primary schools
- 2 parish priests
- Assistant Director, Planning CEOM

The Committee will be serviced by the CEOM.
