This is an inspiring experience that is well worth the visit to the USA for students 15-21 years of age, and also for adult mentors in school and parish contexts. It provides fellowship, teaching and learning tools and strategies, repertoire choices, resources and, importantly a joyful, hope-filled and uplifting experience of Catholic worship and faith-filled community. This partners explicitly with active and Christ-centred mission.
