Program

The Women's Advanced Leadership Program, facilitated by the National Excellence in School Leadership Institute (NESLI) is an integrated development platform. It focuses on the interpersonal and behavioural dynamics associated with a senior leadership position. Participants engage in a deep exploration of their own strengths, gaps and opportunities as they relate to school leadership. The program equips leaders with insights, skills and confidence to accelerate their own career progression as they simultaneously strengthen the performance of their colleagues and their school. Participation in the program has the potential to create powerful, life-long professional networks.

Overview

The program's themes include mindful and authentic leadership, conflict and feedback – the DNA of performance, mastering influencing and negotiation, leading innovation and change and creating your pathway.

This professional learning activity will be delivered over a four-month period to ensure minimal disruption to participants' workload. It will combine three face-to face workshops, rich multimedia presentations and engaging peer level discussion with user-friendly toolkits and activities. Working collaboratively within a cohort of peers, participants will share their insights and experiences and explore the ever-changing role of leadership within the Catholic school community.

The program employs an integrated learning methodology including a capability assessment, interactive online sessions, an adaptive leadership challenge and peer coaching. Throughout the program, self-directed learning content is accessible via an online learning management system.

The program's cost of \$4190 is fully funded by Catholic Education Melbourne.
