Program

The Women's Middle Leadership Program (WMLP), facilitated by the National Excellence in School Leadership Institute (NESLI), is designed to assist women in establishing effective key leadership behaviours and mindsets critical at a middle leadership level. It prepares participants to take the step from self-managing to managing others.

The WMLP focuses on building intrapersonal and interpersonal skills to increase relational trust and overcome everyday challenges that arise within the school. The program aims to build up a holistic framework of leadership that is harmonious with the needs of the participant's school.

Overview

The program conducts a thorough exploration of leadership frameworks. It also provides an opportunity for participants to build connections with their own leadership approach through a focus on building self-awareness.

The program's modules provide strategies to:

- enhance resilience, mindfulness, and wellbeing
- overcome challenges and increase resourcefulness
- utilize communication styles to more effectively connect with others
- employ ways to effectively influence and negotiate across different levels
- increase team collaboration and ways to motivate and inspire staff.

The program will be conducted over four months and will combine two face-to-face workshops, rich multimedia learning resources with peer level discussion and collaboration through webinars. Participants will complete a personal leadership project and be supported with leader as coach sessions. Additionally, the program assists female leaders to create powerful, life-long professional networks.

The program cost of \$2790 is fully funded by Catholic Education Melbourne.
